The scholarship is open to females graduating high school in the year 2022. Students located in public high schools in Clarke, Elbert, Greene and Stephens counties are eligible to apply.

Each applicant **must** submit the following to be considered:

- Completed application
- 1-2 pages typed essay using Times New Roman, Size 12 Font on one of the topics
 - provided
- An official copy of their high school transcript

All applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
